The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Stage of curiosity

The stage that you have known and seen Catholics practice their faith, and you want to know more. It could be your friends or a loved one introduce to you, and you are not *quite sure* about the Catholic institution.

Catechumenate

You have had some training for a life in Christ. This stage, you have learned the basic teachings of the Catholic faith. Finally, you decide to "jump in the boat!"

Journey

Fr. Thai will prepare you with the teachings of the Church and the Mystery of God's love for you and humanity: The Catholic Church will receive you.

Initiation

RCIA is a process of learning and growing. You will take the initiative to be received into the Catholic Church and accept the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist on the Easter Vigil Mass.

Reflections

After Easter Celebration, I invite you to reflect upon you the journey, process, and mystery of the Sacraments and the Eucharist that you are participating in.
